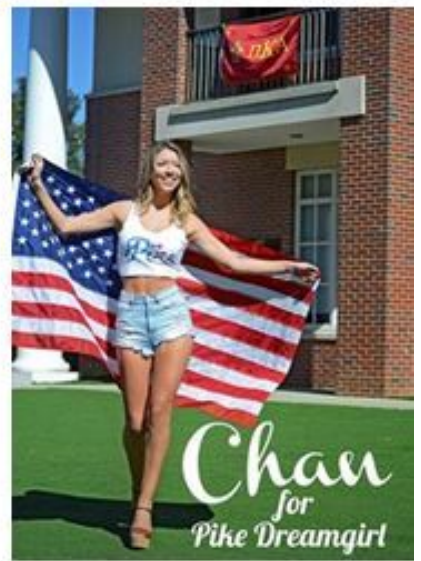

Allen Richardson lives in Evergreen, Colorado.

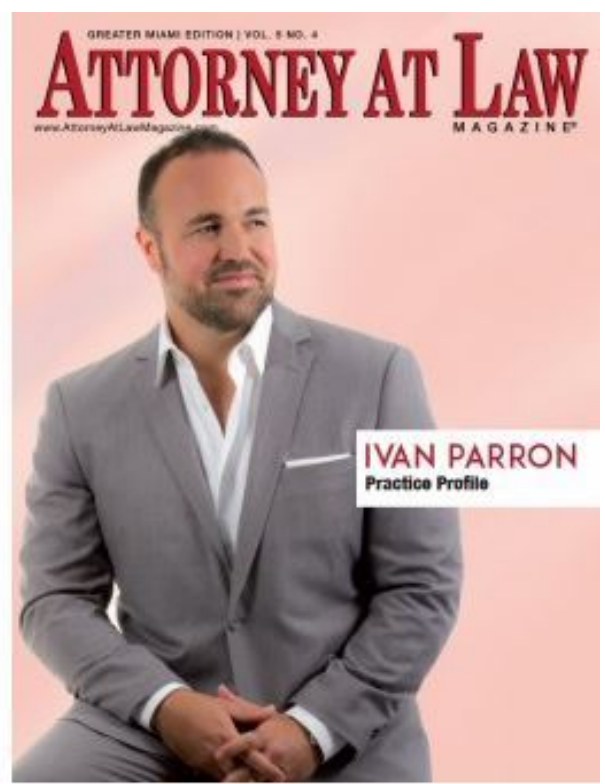
Tim Radomski lives in Alpharetta, Georgia.

How Roberto Aguayo Learned to Recite the Preamble

Delta Lambda Brother **Roberto Aguayo '12** graduated with the distinction of being the best kicker in college football history. The three-time Consensus All-American and Lou Groza Award winner attempted 271 kicks in his career and missed only eight, making him the most accurate kicker in NCAA history. He never missed an extra point. Aguayo and Deion Sanders are the only two three-time Consensus All-Americans in FSU history.

Phil Doumar '09 was the starting long snapper for the Seminoles' 2013 National Championship team. He was also named Delta Gamma Anchor Man, and served Delta Lambda Chapter as rush chairman for two years.

Phil remembers, "It was early in the fall 2012 season and we had just pledged Roberto. I was excited to have him be a part of our chapter and Roberto was ecstatic to be a part of the most prestigious Fraternity at Florida State. He was a fine new member who attended all of his meetings and bonded well with the Brothers. However, a few weeks into his pledge-ship there was something Roberto had yet to accomplish: he had not learned "The Preamble."

"I saw this unacceptable. Roberto had wanted and committed to becoming a valued member of the Delta Lambda Chapter and it was my responsibility to make sure he learned and understood the meaning of The Preamble. So I struck a deal with Roberto..."

"I broke down The Preamble into five sections: the 'Introduction'... 'For the Establishment'...' For the Promotion'...'For the Mutual Benefit'... and finally, the names of the Founders. I gave him five practices to learn The Preamble and each day I refused to perform the additional long snap repetitions that he wanted until he learned the new section, as well as being able to recite sections from the days prior. Lo and behold by the next week Roberto had learned The Preamble and its meaning."

Doumar laughed and promises, "I guarantee he could recite it flawlessly if you were to ask him tomorrow."
